

Grade 3-4 Supply List Mrs. Thacker

2026 - 2027

Please label each item individually with your child's name using a permanent marker.

- 1 binder - 1" - 1 ½" maximum size only - please do not send larger due to space limitations in desks
- 3 lined scribblers
- 2 dotted interlined exercise books
- 1 package lined loose-leaf
- 1 package unlined paper- hole punched if possible
- 1 package graph paper - hole punched if possible
- 1 package pencil crayons (pre-sharpened at home)
- 1 package felt markers
- computer headphones (in Ziploc bag labelled with child's name)
- 30 cm rigid ruler
- 2 medium or fine tip black permanent markers
- 2 - 4 white erasers (send 2 - keep 2 at home)
- 2 red pens (send 1 keep 1 at home for replacements)
- 2 yellow highlighters
- 6-8 blue or black dry erase markers *send 2 and keep others at home for replacement as needed)
- 2- blue or black pens
- Handheld pencil sharpener
- Several HB pencils (*PLEASE DO NOT SEND MECHANICAL PENCILS) (send 2-3 HB pencils to begin, keep several at home to be replaced as needed)
- Reinforcements - keep a supply both at home and school
- Scissors
- 2 glue sticks (bring one and keep one at home for when needed)
- 1 small white bottle of white glue
- pencil case - large pencil cases do not fit well in desks
- 13 duotangs (These do not need to have pockets. If duotangs are plastic or dark-coloured, please apply labels or masking tape for name and subject prior to bringing to school).
- 1 package of dividers (these do not need to be labelled)

- 1 pocket folder
- Calculator
- Gym runners
- Paint shirt (labelled with name)
- 1 box of Kleenex to help with our classroom supply

Students often forget utensils in their lunches. If you would like to send a small package of plastic forks or spoons they will be added to a classroom supply that students will be able to access when needed.

It would be helpful if students had a small supply of extra pencils, erasers and pens at home that can be brought to school when supplies need to be replenished.
